Export To hudl & krossover

You can export all of your data created during your practice and games over to hudl, krossover or any other third party application that you might use. This data includes: Clips, ODK, Plays and Formations.

Items Needed For Export

- ★ Flash Drive with a folder named “echo”
- ★ T100
- ★ Battery
- ★ Computer (Mac or PC)

Export Clips

Step 1: Plug the flash drive into the front USB port on your T100 (with the T100 turned off).

Step 2: Plug your T100 into your battery and turn the power ON.

Step 3: The T100 will boot up as normal and then the Status LED will begin to blink rapidly. This indicates that your clips are now downloading to your flash drive.

Step 4: Remove the flash drive once the Status LED has stopped blinking rapidly and resumed to solid green LED.

Step 5: Plug your flash drive into your computer and open the “echo” folder.

Step 6: Drag and drop all of your angles and ODK data into hudl mercury.
